MATHS

- You are advised to revise all the work done till now.
- Making *Rangoli* on festivals such as Diwali and Onam is a common practice in India. In many parts of India, people begin their day by creating beautiful rangoli pattern in front of their main doors. Make a rangoli pattern on A3 size sheet using simple shapes.
- Make a model of a clock using simple materials like cardboard for the face of the clock, draw numbers 1-12, create clock hands and attach them at the center.

Science

- Prepare a **Seasonal Wheel**, neatly divided into **four equal sections**, each representing one season—**Summer, Rainy, Winter, and Spring**. In each section, students should write:
 1. The main characteristics of the season
 2. Weather conditions
 3. Common activities, festivals, or events associated with that seasonThe Seasonal Wheel should be colorful, informative, and neatly labelled.

Social studies

Students are required to **design and construct a model of a raft using ice-cream sticks**. The raft should clearly demonstrate the basic structure of a floating platform used for transportation over water. Students may use thread, glue, or other safe craft materials to firmly join the sticks. Care should be taken to ensure proper alignment and balance of the raft. A small label mentioning the student's name, class, and section should be attached to the model.
