Subject: Rising Cases of COVID
For Classes: Pre-School to VIII

Dear parent(s)

The rising positivity rate of COVID cases in the city has raised a serious concern about the health of School students and staff. Thus, the school needs cooperation from the parents and they are requested to ensure the following arrangements while sending their ward to the school:

1. The students should wear mask in a proper way and carry small bottle of sanitizer along with them.
2. The students should be guided to follow COVID appropriate behavior and maintain physical distancing as far as possible.
3. The students should be guided not to share lunch, books, notebooks and stationery items with other students.
4. The students with symptoms ranging from mild to severe illness like fever, cough, shortness of breath, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, loss of taste and smell, sore throat, congestion or running nose, nausea or vomiting and diarrhea etc. should not be sent to the school.
5. It must be ensured that the children above the age of 12 are fully vaccinated and in case their ward is not vaccinated, they must ensure to get them vaccinated.
6. It must also be ensured that the transport vehicle which is being used by their wards is following all safety measures of COVID.
7. It is also advised that if the child or any member of the family shows COVID symptoms, the parents should not send their child to the school.
8. The routine parent visit to the school should be avoided and if necessary, during emergency, they will be required to visit the school with COVID appropriate behavior.

The cooperation from the parents will go a long way in helping the school to ensure safety of the students.
