

Guidelines for Examination:

- The mode of Examination will be Online using Google forms.
- Maximum Marks 80; Duration 2 hrs for Main Subjects and Maximum Marks 40; Duration 1 hr for Sanskrit. The timings for the conduct of Examination of Main Subjects will be 09:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. Timings for uploading of Answers and further submission to the concerned teachers will be from 11:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon. The timings for the conduct of III Language Examination will be 09:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. Timings for uploading of Answers and further submission to the concerned teachers will be from 10:30 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. respectively.
- All sections of one particular class will appear for the Examination at the same time.
- The complete Syllabus of Term-II along with 30% Syllabus of Term-I will be assessed for the Final Examination. (Refer to the details of the chapters as provided by the concerned Subject Teachers).
- Notebook Submission and Subject Enrichment Activity will be assessed under Internal Assessment for 05 marks each.
- These tests are mandatory for each student, otherwise absent will be marked. No grade / marks shall be awarded and zero will be marked for the absentees consequently.
- The format of question papers for main subjects will be Objective (60 Marks) and Subjective (20 Marks: Short Answer type).
- The format of question papers for III Languages will be Objective (30 Marks) and Subjective (10 Marks: Short Answer type).
- Students should be well versed with the chapters for the assessment.
- Students should be ready with water bottle and other stationery material required.
- The student shall login to Gmail Account with the same Gmail id that is used for attempting the test.
- The links of the Question Paper for each subject (Online Examination) will be shared by the concerned teacher on the respective WhatsApp groups and Google Class Room 5 minutes prior to the commencement of the Examination.
- Click on the respective links for the tests.
- While attempting the tests, use the scroll bar to move up and down the page.
- Click on the "Submit" button before the expiry of the allotted time as per the test.
- In case of siblings, the students shall use two different Gmail IDs.
- Students who are found to share the Google form link with anyone, will be disqualified and will not be given a second chance to reattempt the paper. The students will be consequently marked 'Zero' in the Examination.
- If anyone faces network issues, then one should have a backup plan as no chance for reattempt will be given.
- The test will begin and end at the stipulated time probably. Under no circumstances, the time will be extended or reattempt option will be given.
